

a local landmark business, Shockets. The southern building is a brick two-story federal styled building with a pent roof and evidence of previously existing dormers. The northern building is a brick three story, Victorian style town house. Both properties have modified storefronts on the first floor. Both facades are covered by formstone that the owner would like to remove and restore the original brick facades. He has contracted with New Faces masonry to remove all of the formstone and repoint the mortar joints.

The committee made many suggestions to the owner about retaining and not adding to the cornice of the Victorian building; to keep the dormer small and in keeping with the size of the original dormer opening and materials.

The owner was referred to the Facade Improvement Grant program.

Decision: Approved formstone removal; brick cleaning and pointing

7:20 pm 223 E. Churchill St. Tom Scercy

This is a 3 story brick Greek revival styled townhouse. The owner would like to put a roof top deck and pergola on top of his house. The current plans would place the rails of the rooftop deck and the pergola are above the highest point of the roof. The DRC members recommended eliminating the pergola and redesigning the deck to meet the legal requirements.

Decision: Not approved

7:40 pm 2010 Eastern Vasilios Navroulis

This is a Greek revival styled townhouse. the owner would like to clean the front of the building. There was much discussion as to whether the brick was painted. If painted, the owner needs to have a licensed contractor to remove paint.
