WAR OF 1812 DISCOVERY TOUR

The Baltimore National Heritage Area War of 1812 Education and Curriculum Committee and the Maryland War of 1812 Bicentennial Commission developed the War of 1812 Discovery Tour to educate Marylanders to recognize the historic sites in Baltimore that played a significant role in the War of 1812.

Discovery Tour highlights:

- Fort McHenry National Monument and Historic Shrine, primary location of Baltimore's defense – Interpretive program on the War of 1812 and tour of Fort.
- Maryland Historical Society – Preview of what will be in the upcoming War of 1812 exhibit and a tour of the current Star-Spangled Banner gallery.
- Box Lunch at Maryland Historical Society – Presentation about the Chasseur: The Original "Pride of Baltimore" and history of today's Pride of Baltimore II, by Pierre Henkart, POB2 Historian. A replica of a Baltimore privateer will be on display.
- Star-Spangled Banner Flag House –

Tour the house, built in 1793, where Mary Pickersgill made our iconic flag, The Star-Spangled Banner.

- Fell's Point – Tour of the area where Baltimore schooners were built and many privateers were based.
- Patterson Park/Hampstead Hill – the site of Rodgers Bastion and the location of earthworks used in the defense of Baltimore against the British land force.
